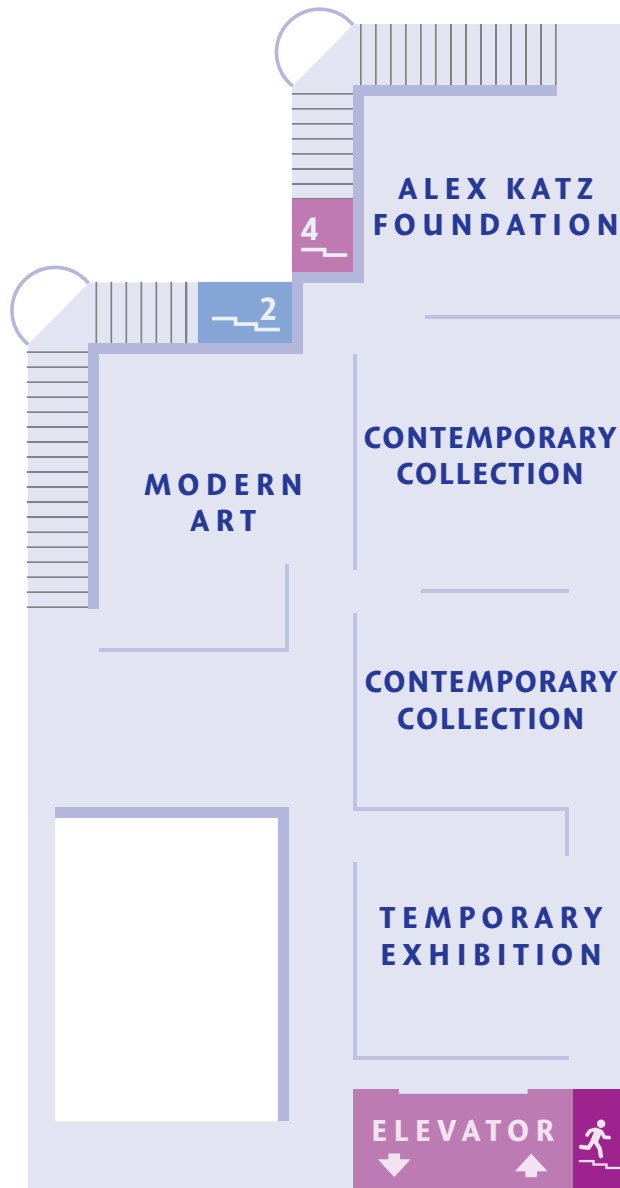


MAIN ENTRANCE

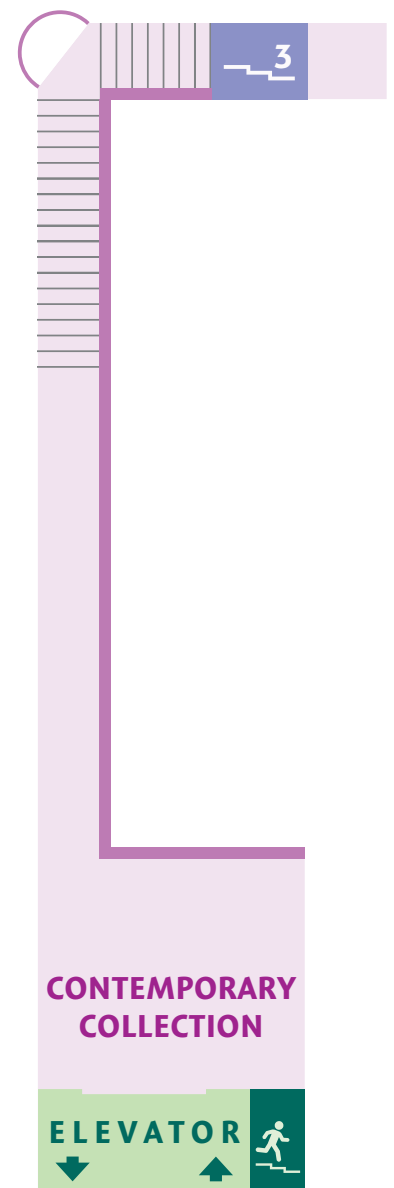

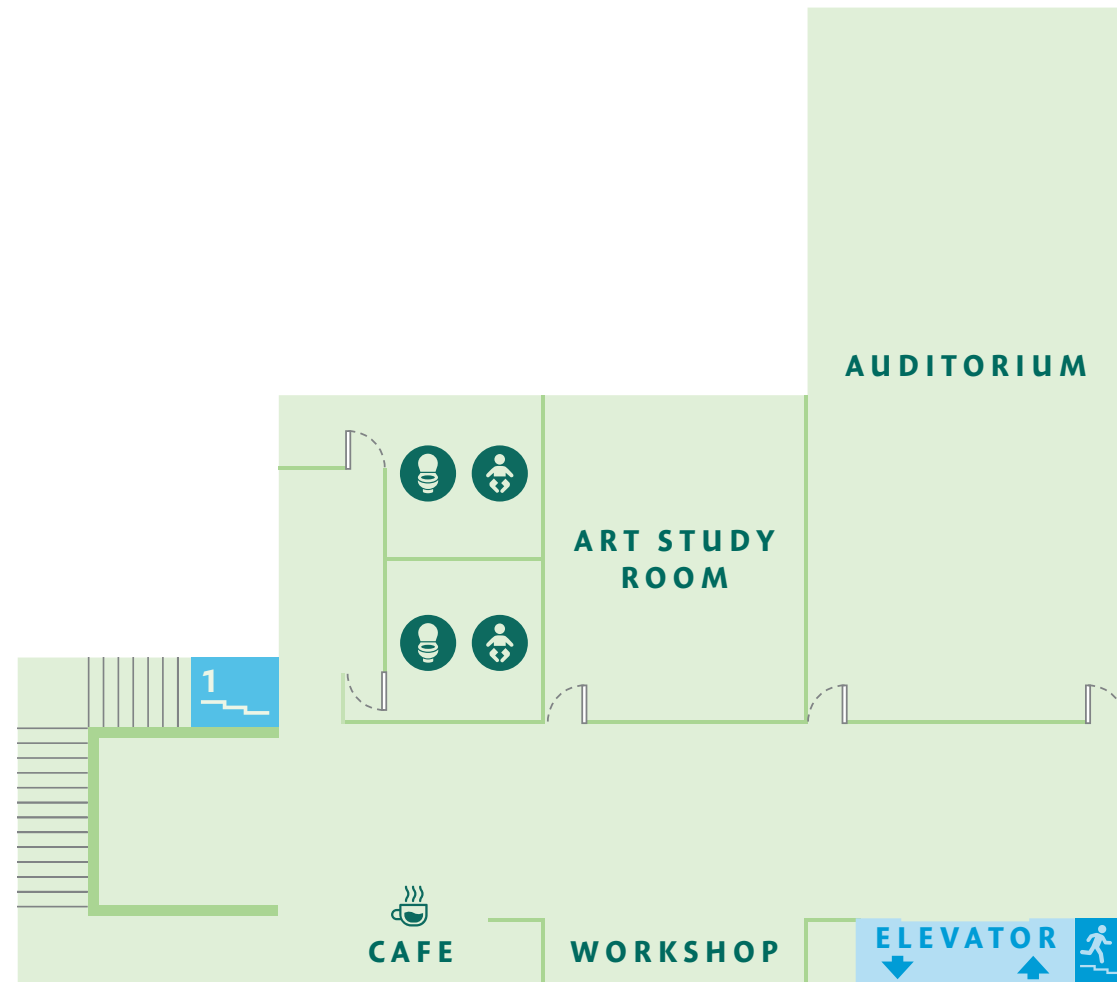

The PMA also offers an audio guide to the collection with portions available in French. All audio content is fully transcribed and the website for the audio guide is screen-reader friendly.
